

Travel to SVEPM 2012 at the Grand Central Hotel in Glasgow.

Flight:

If flying to Glasgow International (majority of airlines into Glasgow):

BEST OPTION

There are frequent buses (about every 10 minutes) from the airport to Glasgow Central Station 24 hours a day. Use "First's Glasgow Shuttle service 500" which takes only 25 minutes and should leave from Bus Stop number 1. Open returns cost £7. The bus stops in Glasgow on the corner of Bothwell street and Hope Street (just 50 metres from Glasgow Central Station).

OR

There are eight trains an hour to Glasgow Central Station from Paisley Gilmour Street station, which is about 1 mile from the airport. Two bus services (numbers 66 and 300) run from the airport to Paisley Gilmour Street station.

If flying to Glasgow Prestwick (Ryanair):

Trains run direct from Glasgow Prestwick to Central Station every 30 minutes. The journey takes approximately 45 minutes and currently costs £13.40 for two singles.

If flying to Edinburgh (a lot of airlines):

Take the Edinburgh AirLink bus service (number 100) to Haymarket Train Station. The journey takes approximately 20 minutes and costs £3.50 one way. Then take the train to Glasgow Queen Street (approximately 45 minutes journey time; every 15 minutes) or Glasgow Central (between 60 and 90 minutes journey time; three services per hour).

Train:

If arriving at Glasgow Central (from the majority of UK locations):

Simply walk off your train and enter the Hotel via an entrance toward the top left hand corner (if walking away from the trains) of the concourse.

If arriving at Glasgow Queen Street (from Edinburgh):

Take the bus to Central station or walk (10 minutes). If walking – leave Glasgow Queen Street station via the Dundas Road exit, head left down the hill crossing George Street, diagonally away from the

station. You will find the pedestrianised Buchanan Street. Walk down this street crossing St Vincent Street as far as Gordon Street on your right (5 minutes). Walk along Gordon Street, crossing West Nile Street and then Union Street. You will see the main entrance to the Grand Central Hotel on the corner of Gordon Street and Hope Street on your left (there is a statue of a fireman directly outside the entrance).

Road:

Car parking is available at Glasgow Central Station costing £15 per day.

Follow directions to Glasgow Central Central (postcode G1 4PA). Vehicle access is from Midland Street (see map). Due to the one-way system access to Midland street is via Oswald Street only, which can be reached via Broomielaw or Commerce Street. Street map:
